**100% Polyester – Premier Blazers
(woven polyester twill)
(DL1990/1991)**

Fabric Content: 100% Polyester
Construction: Woven Twill with anti-reflective fibre

The David Luke Premier Blazer is made of a fabric designed not to reflect light, this gives the colour a more matt appearance. The Teflon coating giving extra stain resistance, it also makes the garment less likely to pill.

WEAR

These blazers are very hard wearing and can, if cared for correctly, last for a long time. However one common cause of fabric damage and reduction in the quality of the blazers appearance is abrasion by certain kinds of rucksack's. Rough nylon rucksacks when worn against the blazer can cause pilling and will damage the fabric.....make sure you choose your rucksack carefully!

WASHING

- Can be machine washed at 40°C, not too dirty, wash at 30, but avoid strong fabric conditioners, they can be Dry Cleaned if preferred.

DRYING

- For best results, do not tumble dry your blazers, simply hang up to dry.

IRONING

- In general, if the garment is hung up to dry it shouldn't need ironing, however if you feel it needs a press to get a smart finish, do not iron directly on the fabric use a clean damp cloth between the garment and the iron. Direct ironing on polyester will cause damage and result in a shiny appearance.
- Blazers can be steamed to revive any creasing.
