



The **Smarter Choice**

**100% Polyester – Boys shadow stripe/mesh shorts  
(Knitted Polyester)  
(DL11/12)**

Fabric Content: 100% Polyester  
Construction: Jaguard Knit Design

Shorts made from this fabric are very easy to care for! The colour is bright and dynamic, they also have a great soft feel.

**WASHING**

- Always wash at 40°C. Not too dirty, wash at 30. Higher temperatures may cause shrinkage or affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colours separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners.

**DRYING**

- These shorts do dry very quickly if left to dry naturally but if you want to tumble dry them, ensure they are on a cool setting.

**IRONING**

- Ironing is not necessary for these shorts in the main however if you want to iron, use a cool iron setting and also use a clean, damp cloth between the garment and the iron. Do not iron directly on to the garment and do not use excessive heat as this makes the fabric brittle.

**Polyester Cotton Twill – boys sports shorts**  
**(DL 14/15/49)**

Fabric Content: 65% Polyester & 35% Cotton  
Construction: Hardwearing Twill Weave

David Luke sports shorts are hardwearing and comfortable, ideal for most sports.

**WASHING**

- Wash at 40°C as synthetic, or if "not too dirty, wash at 30". High temperatures will fade cotton fabric. Wash dark colours separately to avoid any loose dye transfer. If you leave trimmed or coloured garments mixed with other washing in a wet condition, colour transfer may occur. Do not boil, this will also damage the fabric.

**IRONING**

- Use a warm iron directly on to the fabric for a smart finish

**DRYING**

- Can be tumble dried on a cool setting but we don't recommend tumble drying. Hang out to dry naturally. If the garment is tumble dried too hot for too long, it will damage the fibres, particularly the elastic in the waistband. Take extra care when using this method of drying.

**Polyester Twill – Game Skirts**  
**(DL910)**

Fabric Content: 100% Polyester  
Construction:

David Luke games skirts are easy to care for and if washed/dried correctly will maintain colour and shape through their life.

#### WASHING

- Wash at 40°C. Not too dirty, wash at 30. Higher temperatures may cause shrinkage, affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colours separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners as they can damage the fibres. The pleats could fall out if washed at too high a temperature.

#### IRONING

- Games skirts don't generally need ironing, they will re-shape themselves if hung up after washing. However if you want to improve the creases, use a steam iron on a clean damp cloth, do not iron directly on to the garment. Pleats will be damaged and go shiny if ironed.

#### DRYING

- Do not tumble dry as the pleats will disappear, for best results simply hang up after washing.

## **Cotton Drill – Shorts (DL16)**

Fabric Content: 100% Cotton  
Construction: Heavyweight Drill

Extremely hardwearing yet comfortable shorts, the DL16 is a fantastic short to have. It has brushed back cotton on the inside of the garment to give it a softer feel also making it very comfortable. Over a period of time, even when cared for correctly, there may be a certain amount of colour loss.

### WASHING

- Wash at 40°C, or if "not too dirty, wash at 30". Higher temperatures may cause shrinkage, affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colours separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners as they can damage the fibres.

### IRONING

- Iron on appropriate setting directly on to the short

### DRYING

- These shorts can be tumble dried but not a hot setting as this will cause damage to the fabric or elastic to the waistband. It is likely to shrink the shorts if left too long in the drier.
