## **Polyviscose – Trousers & Shorts**

**(DL940, DL946, DL939, DL943, DL945, DL948, DL950, DL957)**

Fabric Construction: 67% Polyester, 33% Viscose woven twill

David Luke trousers are renowned for being the best quality School Trousers on the market. The way the fabric is woven ensures a smooth finish as well as giving them hard wearing qualities. Most are made from worsted woven fabric, which is woven on looms using finer yarns. The fabric is really strong and gives tremendous wear and smartness.

### WASHING

- Wash at 40°C. Higher temperatures may cause shrinkage, affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colours separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners as they can break the fibres.

### IRONING

- NEVER iron on the face fabric of the garment, as it will change the appearance of the garment to make it shiny.
- Use a cool iron setting and also use a clean, damp cloth between the garment and the iron.

### DRYING

- Do not tumble dry, for best results we recommend simply drip drying our trousers. If necessary, tumble dry with care.
