100% Cotton interlock fabric - T-shirts & Singlets
(DL 406/ 407/ 420/ 421/ 422)

Fabric Construction : 100% cotton

This fabric has a heavier feel than single jersey and is used for singlets as well as the T-shirt. We also make schoolbriefs and polo necks from the same cotton interlock. Below are some guidelines on caring for your garment to optimise performance.

WASHING

- Always wash at 40°C, high temperatures will fade cotton fabric. Wash dark colours separately to avoid any loose dye transfer. If you leave trimmed or coloured garments mixed with other washing in a wet condition, colour transfer may occur.

SHRINKAGE

- As cotton is a natural fibre it usually needs reshaping. The garment will return to its original shape every time if you fold it lengthways twice, hold the top in one hand and the bottom in the other then pull back to shape. It's simple and it works.

DRYING

- If the garment is tumble dried too hot for too long, it will damage the fibres. Take extra care when using this method of drying.

IRONING

- Use an iron with steam to bring the soft feel back. Never iron directly on to a print.
